PROFESSIONAL BACKGROUND

Dr. Hancock completed his undergraduate training in Genetics at the University of Georgia graduating *summa cum laude*. He then earned a medical degree from the Medical College of Georgia and conducted two years of stem cell neurodevelopment research in graduate school at the Medical College of Georgia. He then completed a transitional internship at Carolinas Medical Center. Dr. Hancock subsequently completed a four year residency in diagnostic radiology at the University of Miami and was voted chief resident; becoming Board Certified in Diagnostic Radiology by the American Board of Radiology. Following neuroradiology fellowship training at the University of Miami, Dr. Hancock assumed the position of Director of Neuroradiology at Mount Sinai Medical Center and served as associate program director for the MSMC Department of Radiology residency program. During his tenure at MSMC, Dr. Hancock received the certification of added qualification in neuroradiology accreditation from the American Board of Radiology. Currently, Dr. Hancock is the Assistant Clinical Professor of Radiology at Loma Linda University Medical Center, Councilor of the American College of Radiology, Board Member of the Riverside County Medical Association, and Delegate to the American Medical Association. His active research interests include autologous mesenchymal stem cell therapy, Alzheimer's disease and dementia, cognitive impairment related microvascular ischemic disease, and minimally invasive spine surgery. Dr. Hancock has presented, authored and co-authored numerous abstracts, journal articles, and internet publications on topics such as stem cell, musculoskeletal MRI, CNS tumors, Alzheimer's disease, and postoperative spine imaging. He has also lectured on contrast agent, musculoskeletal and neuroradiology topics both locally and nationally.
